93rd General Assembly Tuesday, Nov. 17, 2020

LEGISLATIVE PREFILING OPENED YESTERDAY

Prefiling of bills and resolutions for the 93rd General Assembly began yesterday. The session is scheduled to convene at noon on Monday, Jan. 11, 2021.

Daily Legislative Updates will be published as needed until the Session begins; then they will be published daily. As we've done in the past, bills we add to our tracking categories will be reported in pre-session *Daily Legislative Updates* and posted on our website in one of our subject matter categories.

STATE CHAMBER/AIA 2021 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA and BILL SCORING

At its Annual Board Meeting on November 10, the State Chamber and AIA Boards adopted a legislative agenda for the 93rd General Assembly. To view the agenda, click [here](#).

The agenda was developed through a series of State Chamber/AIA issue-based committee meetings that began in late August and were completed in mid-October. Our focus in the session will be on the items in the Priority Issues section of the Agenda. This Agenda is subject to change.

For the third consecutive legislative session, we will score floor votes. Issues related to items in our Legislative Agenda and issues we take a position on in *Daily Legislative Updates* are subject to being scored.

We were delighted that 33 of 35 Senators and 86 of 100 State Representatives voted 70 percent or higher on more than 30 bills that we scored in the 92nd General Assembly. These legislators were presented our *Business Matters Legislative Leadership Award* in or near their district after the session last year. Also, the scoring was a factor in our PAC contribution decisions. We are grateful and delighted to receive such strong support on business issues.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES

The Senate held an organizational meeting on November 6, in which they selected their committees. You may view the Senate Committee rosters by clicking [here](#).

The House also met on Nov. 6 to select committees but adjourned after just a few minutes. The official outcome of elections in House Districts 32 and 38 have not yet been determined. Because these races will impact seniority standing, which in turn impacts committee selections, the House chose to postpone their organizational meeting until those two elections are finalized. The most recent information we have is that incumbent Republican Rep. Carlton Wing has been certified as the winner in District 38. Democrat Ashley Hudson has taken a lead over incumbent Republican Rep. Jim Sorvillo in District 32.

LEGISLATIVE SESSION INFORMATION

At this point, no events are being scheduled during the Session. Consequently, we have cancelled our plans to host our Annual Legislative Reception.

Leadership in the House and Senate are working to create a safe environment for the members. We believe that there will be limited access by the public to the Capitol. It is likely the House Committees will meet in the Big MAC building across the street from the Capitol and the Senate Committees will meet in the House Committee rooms. Both bodies are currently planning to hold their floor sessions in their respective chambers.
